Emergency Administration of Epinephrine By A Delegate School Employee Parent/Guardian Authorization

The law provides for the administration of epinephrine via a pre-filled single or double dose auto-injector mechanism to a pupil for anaphylaxis by a delegate school district employee when the nurse is not physically present at the scene i.e. during after school activities and the pupil does not have the capability for self-administration. The school nurse in consultation with the Board of Education or Chief School Administrator will designate a delegate employee.

The school nurse will train the designee employee(s) in the administration of the epinephrine via a pre-filled auto-injector using standardized training procedures.

I, _____ parent/guardian of the above named student consent to the administration of epinephrine via a pre-filled single or double dose auto-injector by a trained delegate when the school nurse is not physically present at the scene i.e. after school activities.

I understand that should epinephrine be administered, my student will be transported to a hospital emergency room by emergency services personnel regardless of his/her condition even if the symptoms appear to have resolved.

I acknowledge that the school district shall have no liability for any good faith act or omission consistent with the law which results in any injury arising from the administration of epinephrine via a pre-filled, single or double dose auto-injector mechanism by a designated employee. I shall indemnify and hold harmless the Board of Education, its officers, employees or agents against any and all claims, suits or causes of action arising out of the administration of the epinephrine via a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism.
