

2312 CLASS SIZE

The Superintendent shall recommend for Board of Education approval the number of class sections for each course. He/she shall also make recommendations for the special needs of particular programs, certain course sequence requirements and predicted future pupil enrollments. Elective courses with fewer than ten pupils shall be reviewed by the Superintendent.

To the extent possible, English courses involving writing should not contain more than twenty pupils. When such courses exceed twenty pupils, the Superintendent shall bring those classes to the Board of Education for approval.

Particular attention shall be paid to space-per-pupil requirements of the state Department of Education.
